INSTALLING POWER BI DESKTOP

You may use either one of the two methods to install Power BI Desktop:

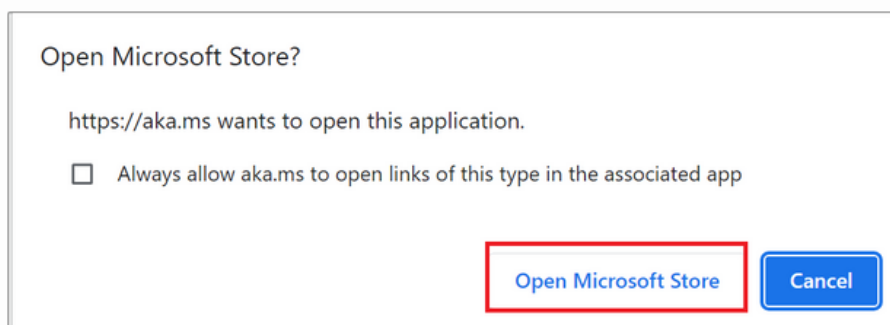
- Install directly from the Microsoft Store as an app.
- Download the executable file and then install it on your system.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Windows 8.1 / Windows Server 2012 R2 or above
- .NET version 4.6.2 or above
- At least 2 GB RAM available. 4 GB or more is recommended.
- Display with a minimum resolution of 1440x900 or 1600x900 is required.
- Windows display setting should be set to 100% otherwise some dialogues might not appear correctly. Go to Settings > System > Display, and use the slider to return display settings to 100%.
- A 64-bit (x64) CPU running at 1 gigahertz (GHz) or above is recommended.
- WebView2 gets automatically installed with Power BI Desktop. If not, click [here](#) to download it.

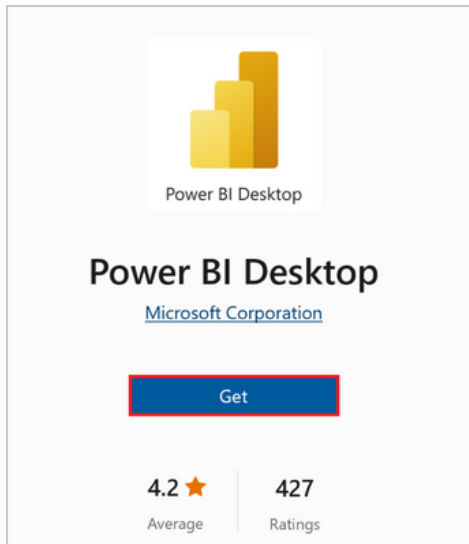
1) INSTALLING FROM MICROSOFT STORE

1. Click [here](#) to open Power BI Desktop page on the Microsoft Store.
2. If prompted, click on Open Microsoft Store in your browser

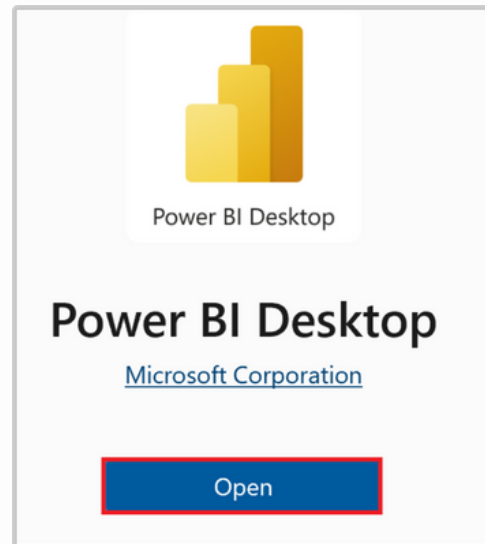

3. Once the Power BI Desktop page of the Microsoft Store loads, click Get

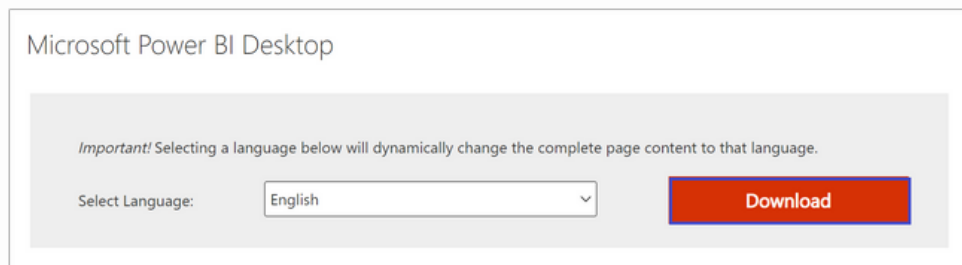


4. After the installation finishes, click on Open to launch Power BI

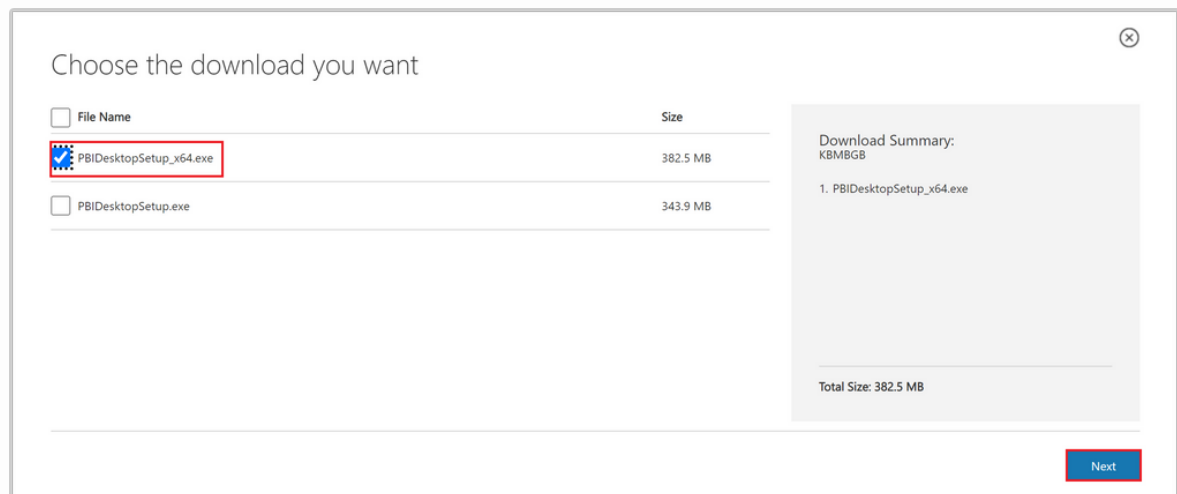


2) DOWNLOAD POWER BI DESKTOP DIRECTLY

1. Click [here](#) to open the download page for Power BI
2. Select your language of choice and click Download

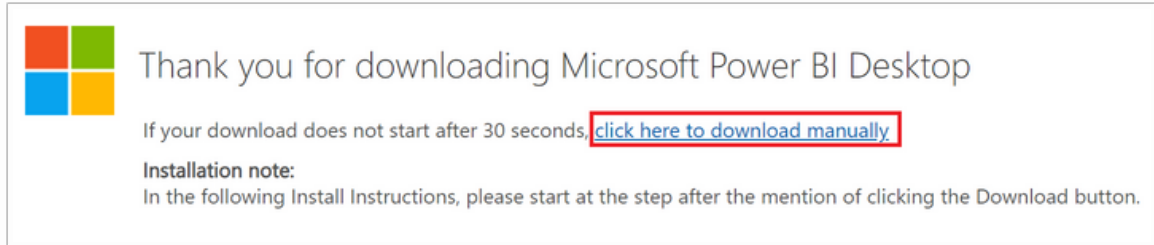


3. Specify a 32-bit or 64-bit installation file to download based on your system and click next

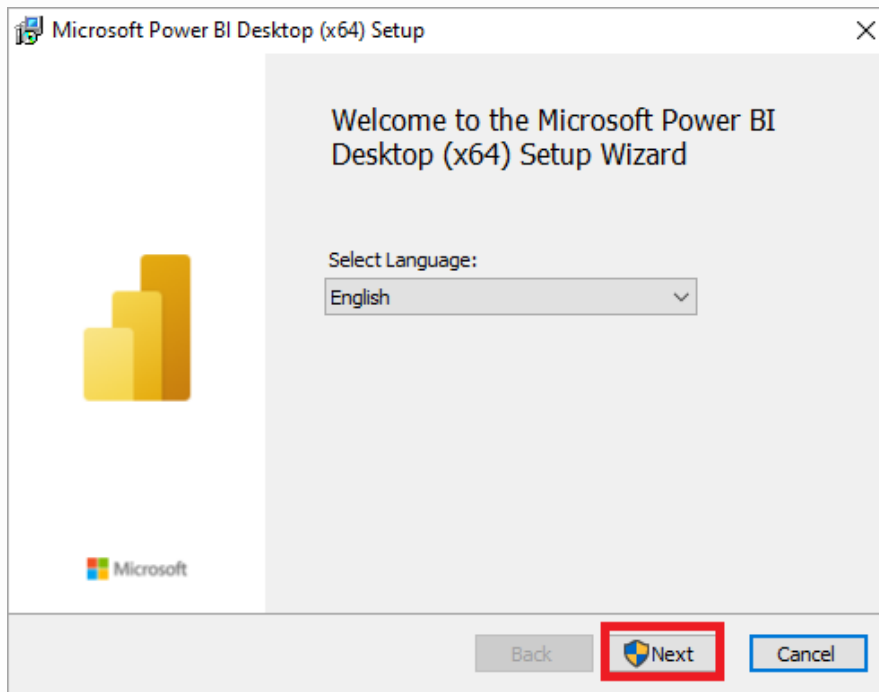
